

Home & School Minutes May 10, 2010

After opening prayer, Scrip was discussed. With just 5 orders placed so far, we've made \$170. It was decided that guidelines and scheduling needs to be created, especially for Summer. The name: Eagle Earners was mentioned as a name for the program. A form needs to be created for parents to sign, when deciding how to receive their Scrip order for the next school year. Also discussed was the need for a system of checks and balances when the cards come in each week. A question was raised about how to clear out the system at the end of the pilot program. Jude Fay has agreed to be the coordinator of this program, along with Diane Curtiss, for the 2010-11 school year. Jude will learn how to place the orders, but will not take over that part until the pilot program has ended. A call for volunteers to man the program will be added to the volunteer options.

Graduation is on track. The seventh grade parents have volunteers scheduled for the event. The caterer will be St. Charles Caterers, Flowers will go on account at Richland Florist for the altar piece and nosegay. Individual flowers for parents will be purchased at Costco. Cake and some paper goods will also come from Costco. Other paper goods will come from Sam's and Cash & Carry. Graduation gifts are on schedule as well. Cost for this event is estimated at just under \$1100.

Spring Fling is over! Early estimates indicate that around \$15,000 was raised. Circumstances prevented the Spring Fling committee to have their final meeting. Discussion was had about what worked and what could make it better for next year. It was suggested that we change the date for next year. An idea surfaced as a result of Spring Fling to create a new picture taking committee and have that as a separate fundraiser for next year.

May Events: Used Uniform Sale – volunteers are being solicited for this event. There was discussion regarding donated uniforms for flood victims. It is believed there are 6-7 families who were severely affected by the flood in the school, and about 15 families in the Parish affected. Athletic Award Night is scheduled for May 14th. Only dessert will be served – parents are to provide desserts. H&S will provide paper goods for this event and Academic Award Night, which is May 27. Field Day – Mrs. Hermann is responsible for that event.

Principal's Report – Mr. Foreman thanked everyone for making Home & School run smoothly this past year, thanking Denese Farmer for her dedication for so many years as Treasurer. He also thanked Home & School for taking on the Scrip Program and making it a reality.

Treasurer's Report: Mrs. Farmer handed over the keys and books to the new Co-Treasurers, who have been learning what is expected of them for the next school year.

There will be no June meeting, but the Home & School Committee will resume in July for the school year 2010-11.
